What will I do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Look after the finances of the League ▪ Collect Registration fees and all Entry Fees for Tournaments and Cup/Plate Rounds ▪ Pay Umpire Fees where applicable ▪ Book and pay for Court Fees where applicable ▪ Keep up to date records of all financial transactions ▪ Ensure that funds are spent appropriately ▪ Issue receipts for monies received ▪ Report regularly to the committee on the clubs financial situation ▪ Preparing an end of year statement for auditing ▪ Present an end of year financial report to the AGM ▪ Financial planning including an annual budget ▪ Apply for sponsorship or other forms of financial assistance ▪ Assist / Coordinate fund raising events ▪ Work with others to promote fund raising events ▪ Ensure that funds are properly accounted for ▪ Sale of lottery style draws/raffles on a regular basis
How much time will I need to give?	Approximately 4 hours per week.
What do I need to do this role?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Keep up to date records for all finances of the League ▪ Need to be well organised and careful when handling money ▪ Scrupulously honest and able to answer questions in meetings ▪ Prepared to make instant decisions when necessary ▪ Be enthusiastic, creative and innovative ▪ Any previous experience of grant application or fund raising would be useful but not essential
